## Rules

### 1. Applicable rules

The Diddelenger Schwammfest is an international swimming event organised by the Cercle de Natation Dudelange (the “**Organiser**”). The event will be run in accordance with the rules of the international swimming federation FINA and the Luxembourg swimming federation FLNS.

### 2. Venue

The competition takes place at the swimming pool of the Campus Geesseknäppchen (31, boulevard Pierre Dupong; L-1430 Luxembourg).

The competition pool has 50m and 10 lanes. Timekeeping is operated by electronic OMEGA timing.

A 25m warm up pool is available throughout the competition.

### 3. Age groups

All swimmers will be classified in an OPEN classification.

In addition, all female swimmers born in 2007, 2008 and 2009 and all male swimmers born in 2006, 2007 and 2008 will be classified in the YOUTH age group. All female swimmers born in 2010, 2011 and 2012 and all male swimmers born in 2009, 2010 and 2011 will be classified in the YOUTH age group.

Girls born in 2013 or later and boys born in 2012 and younger cannot register for the event.

### 4. Time standards

For each event, the organiser has defined two different time standards called the ACCEPTED time standard and the CONSIDERED time standards by year of birth.

All swimmers with an entry time faster than the ACCEPTED time standard swum in a 50m pool is automatically accepted.

For all swimmers with an entry time faster than the ACCEPTED time standard swum in a 25m pool or with an entry time faster than the CONSIDERED time standard swum in a 50m pool will be accepted as long as the competition timeline is respected.

The organiser reserves the right to prioritise swimmers from clubs affiliated to the FLNS when allocated places with CONSIDERED time standards.

For the list of time standards, please refer to the corresponding tables.

## 5. Finals

All individual 50m, 100m and 200m events with more than ten (10) swimmers will be swum in heats and finals.

The ten (10) fastest swimmers across all age groups qualify for the OPEN final.

The ten (10) next fastest swimmers from the YOUTH age group qualify for the YOUTH final.

The ten (10) next fastest swimmers from the KIDS age group qualify for the KIDS final.

If fewer than ten (10) swimmers are registered for an event, the registered swimmers automatically qualify for the OPEN final.

**All withdrawals from a final must be declared within thirty (30) minutes following the publication of the official results from the heats. A fee of €30 per absent swimmer in a final will be charged.**

For the individual 400m races, the events are swum as direct finals. The ten (10) fastest swimmers will compete in the fast heat in the afternoon sessions. The remaining swimmers will swim in the slow heats in the morning sessions.

## 6. Individual prizes

The first three swimmers of the OPEN final will be awarded prize money (1<sup>st</sup>: €40, 2<sup>nd</sup>: €20, 3<sup>rd</sup>: €10).

The three fastest swimmers of the YOUTH and KIDS age groups from the open and YOUTH/KIDS final will be awarded medals.

Any swimmer who breaks a meet record will be awarded €50. If the meet record for the same event is broken more than once, the swimmer who swims the last meet record will be awarded the prize.

## 7. Team classification

A team classification will be established in two stages:

- Point ranking

In each individual event, the 20 fastest swimmers in the OPEN classification in the heats will be awarded points:

- Team classification relay

The ten first teams of the point ranking qualify for the team classification relay, which will be swum as a 4x50m mixed freestyle relay.

This relay will be swum in four rounds. At the end of rounds 1, 2 and 3, the two slowest teams of each round will be eliminated. In round 4, the four remaining teams will swim for the team trophy. The first three teams of round 4 will be awarded trophies. In addition, the winner of the team classification relay will be awarded €200.

The rest time between each round will be three (3) minutes.

## **8. Entry fees and registration**

Entries should be submitted with the “Splash” software. All entries must be sent via email at [meeting@cndu.lu](mailto:meeting@cndu.lu).

Entry deadline: Wednesday 20 April at 18.00 (6.00 PM). No additional entries will be accepted after the deadline.

### **Entry fee: €5,20 per individual event**

20 cents of the entry fees will be donated to TELEVIE.

Entry fee must be transferred to the account of CNDU (IBAN LU49 0030 0516 4979 0000, BGLLULL) by Wednesday 27 April 2022. Please use “Schwammfest 2022” as a reference for your payment.

## **9. Officials**

The referees for the event will be nominated by the FLNS.

Each club is invited to provide officials for the different sessions of the competition.

## **10. Responsibility**

The organiser declines all responsibility in case of theft or accidents.

## **Practical information**

### **1. Lunch**

The organiser organises lunch (salad, main course, desert and water) within the premises of the competition venue at €15. Please book your lunch via email ([meeting@cndu.lu](mailto:meeting@cndu.lu)). The lunch for the officials is at the charge of the organiser. Please do not include the officials in your booking.

### **2. Beverages and snacks**

A selection of beverages, snacks and cakes is available throughout the weekend.
