* The 50 m and 400 m races are swum in an open category only. For this reason, the entry time standards are the same for all swimmers.


## Rules and regulations

## 1. Applicable rules

The Challenge International de la Ville de Dudelange is an international swimming competition organised by the Cercle de Natation Dudelange (hereafter the "Organiser").

The event is organised in accordance with the rules of the World Aquatics ("AQUA") and the Luxembourg swimming federation ("FLNS").

## 2. Venue

The event takes place at the swimming pool of the Centre sportif René Hartmann. The competition pool is 25 m long and has 6 lanes. The temperature is set at $27^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$.

OMEGA automatic officiating equipment and OMEGA back stroke ledges will be in use.
A warm up pool will be available throughout the event.

## 3. Age groups

For the $50 \mathrm{~m}, 400 \mathrm{~m}$ and relay events the swimmers will be classified in an open category.
For the 100 m and 200 m events, the following age groups apply:

Swimmers born in 2014 and after cannot enter the competition.

## 4. Entry and time standards

Swimmers with a valid licenced with the Luxembourg swimming federation (FLNS) as well as clubs affiliated with a AQUA member federation may participate, provided that the satisfy the entry time standards set for each race.

For individual races, the Organiser has set two time standards referred to as ACCEPTED and CONSIDERED time standards.

All swimmers with an entry time corresponding to a time swum at a previous competition that is faster than the ACCEPTED time standard are automatically admitted to the respective race.

For swimmers with entry times faster than the respective CONSIDERED time standard may be admitted as long as the competition schedule can be respected. The Organiser reserves the right to prioritise swimmers affiliated with the FLNS when considering entries on the basis of CONSIDERED time standards.

All time standards are listed in the table printed on page 3 of this document.

Swimmers without an official time or with times slower than the CONSIDERED time standards will not be admitted to the respective race.

For relay events each club may enter up to two teams per event. The list of swimmers on each relay team must be submitted to the competition office at least 30 minutes before the start of the session for which the relay is scheduled. Each team must consist of 2 women and 2 women.

## 5. Individual prices

In the 50m events, the six fastest swimmers qualify for the A final, the next six swimmers qualify for the $B$ final. The three fastest swimmers of the A final will be awarded medals.

For the 100 m events, there will be age groups finals except for the age group 2012-2013. The six fastest swimmers per age group proceed to the finals. The three fastest swimmers in each final are awarded medals. For the 2012-2013 age group medals are awarded on the basis of the results in the heats.

The $\mathbf{2 0 0 m}$ and 400 m events are swum as direct finals. In the 200 m events, the three fastest swimmers in each age group are awarded medals. In the 400 m events, the three fastest swimmers are awarded medals.

The swimmers of the three fastest relay teams are awarded medals.

## 6. Team classification

A team classification between the participating clubs is determined on the basis of its swimmers' performance.

For individual events, points will be awarded to clubs for swimmers in positions 1-8 in the heats/direct finals ( $1^{\text {st }}=10$ points, $2^{\text {nd }}=8$ points, $3^{\text {rd }}=6$ points, $4^{\text {th }}=5$ point, $5^{\text {th }}=4$ points, $6^{\text {th }}=3$ points, $7^{\text {th }}=2$ points, $8^{\text {th }}=1$ point).

For relay events, points will be awarded to the eight best teams ( $1^{\text {st }}=40$ points, $2^{\text {nd }}=32$ points, $3^{\text {rd }}=24$ points, $4^{\text {th }}=20$ points, $5^{\text {th }}=16$ points, $6^{\text {th }}=12$ points, $7^{\text {th }}=8$ points, $8^{\text {th }}=4$ points).

Trophies will be awarded to the three best teams in the team classification. In addition, the following prizes will be awarded:

## 7. Entry procedure

Entries should be done with the "Splash" software. Teams who do not have the software at their disposal are invited to contact the Organiser in order to check the options to submit their entries. Entries need to be sent via email at meeting@cndu.lu.

## Deadline for entries: Thursday 2 November 2022 at 18.00 (6pm).

Entry fees: 6 € per race

Entry fees must be paid to the Organiser's account (IBAN LU49 003005164979 0000, BGLLULL) avec la by 8 November 2022. Please use the reference "Challenge 2023".

There will be no reimbursement in the case of a swimmer's absence or withdrawal.

Heats will be seeded independently of age groups on the basis of entry times. The Organiser reserves the right to amend the program or to limit the number of entries.

## 8. Withdrawals

All withdrawals for heats must be declared at least 30 minutes before the respective sessions.

Withdrawlals for finals must be declared within 30 minutes following the publication of the results and the list of the qualifiers. A fine of $15 €$ will be charged for every swimmer not present at a final.
9. Jury

The referees are appointed by the Fédération Luxembourgeoise de Natation et de Sauvetage (FLNS).

Each participating club must appoint 2 officials for the jury. Clubs with more than 20 swimmers are required to appoint 3 officials.
10. Responsability

The Organiser declines all responsibility in case of theft, accidents or any other incurred damage.

## Practical information

1. Lunch

The Organiser has a lunch offer (salad, main dish, fruit \& water) provided by a local restaurant at the competition venue at the prize of $€ 16$. All lunch reservations need to be made via meeting@cndu.lu.

The organiser offers lunch to the officials.

A selection of drinks and snacks can be purchased throughout the weekend.
3. Hotels
